## All Rounder Award 2004/2005 - Kelly Fung

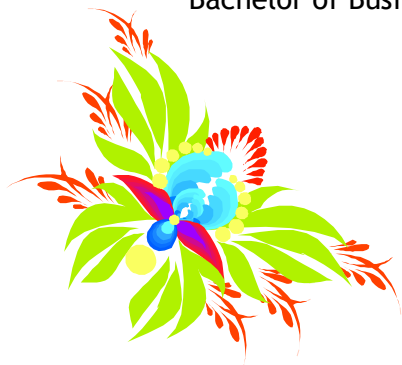


